This documentary film is a journey to the heart of coca country in Colombia, where U.S. tax dollars have financed chemical spraying of the Amazon for the past nine years in the ‘War On Drugs’.

Hear first hand testimony from people on the ground about the impacts and learn new ideas about how to solve this deadly problem.

PLUS A SHORT FEATURE (13 min) Since 2000, the U.S. government has provided nearly \$5 billion in military and police funding to Colombia. This film examines the extrajudicial killings at the hands of the U.S.-funded Colombian military, as well as the astoundingly high rates of impunity for these.
